Sometimes this is just not possible, but your child will have a chance to decline the part if you can't work it out to where they can be at rehearsals a reasonable amount of time.

We are so glad for your interest in theater. Accepting a role in a play is a big commitment. Depending on the role, it takes 1 to 3 nights of rehearsal a week for about 7 weeks and then rehearsal every day starting the Saturday prior to the production. Rehearsals will be Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. There may be an occasional Saturday rehearsal called if needed. Principal characters will normally rehearse all 3 nights a week. Minor roles will rehearse 1-3 nights a week. You will be asked to list any conflicts Tuesday, January 2nd through Thursday, February 15th on the audition form. Show week practices are **MANDATORY**.

There will be a **one-time** participation fee due at the first cast meeting in November. We do not want this to be a hardship on any family or cause any child not to be able to participate due to financial reasons. Please contact the directors if there is a financial concern.

Regular attendance at rehearsals to learn songs, lines, and choreography **is required** to be in the show. We understand that cast members sometimes have to miss due to an **OCCASIONAL** conflict or illness. However, if your child is cast, it is your responsibility to check for conflicts once the rehearsal schedule is published. If they are already committed to other activities during their scheduled rehearsal times that are not flexible and will not allow them to be at rehearsal on a regular basis, it is best to decline the part before starting. If the child accepts the role and has excessive absences not due to emergencies or illness, it will be necessary to release them from the cast. Any **payments** made toward scripts, t-shirts, or costumes **WILL NOT** be refunded. Cast list and cast meeting will be posted at the completion of auditions. The 1st rehearsal of the year is scheduled for January 2nd at 6:00 at First Baptist Church.

- Peter Pan** a boy without a care in the world.
- Wendy** the eldest of the Darling children and has a certain maternal quality.
- John** the middle Darling child and has an amicable and proper demeanor.
- Michael** the youngest Darling boy and seems to have unlimited energy.
- Nana** the dog, great for a person that is good with physical comedy.
- Mrs. Darling** mother of Wendy, John and Michael.
- Mr. Darling** father of Wendy, John and Michael, has no time for nonsense.
- Liza** the Darling's housekeeper who always seems to be in a bit of a frenzy.
- Tiger Lily** fearless leader of the Brave Girls.
- Captain Hook** the leader of the Pirates. Though Captain Hook is the villain of the show, he's also a bit of a clown who just can't seem to get what he wants.
- Smee** Smee is Captain Hook's sidekick who wants nothing more than to see Captain Hook succeed in his evil plotting.
- Brave Girls** The Brave Girls, including Brave Girl #1, Brave Girl #2 and Small Brave Girl, are a group of Neverland inhabitants. They are a fun bunch of girls who are as strong as they are kind.
- Lost Boys** a group of lads who live in Neverland without a care in the world! Roles such as Nibs, Slightly, Curley, Tootles, Twin #1 and Twin # 2.
